This is not a symbolic visit, but an impact journey. A unique opportunity to see first-hand what structural investment truly makes possible.

Impact at the core of our mission

At CFP Green Buildings, we work every day on future-proof buildings. As a B Corp, we believe that impact is not a marketing term, but a responsibility. That is why we have been investing in projects worldwide for many years, with one clear principle: impact must be structural and measurable.

Our impact in Nepal in numbers

Since 2019, CFP, together with partners and the Unica Foundation, has been structurally investing in projects in Nepal.



About Nepal

Nepal is a country of strong contrasts. Alongside its natural and cultural richness, it faces significant poverty. Millions of people lack access to clean water and sanitation, while targeted, relatively small investments can make a substantial difference.



Clean drinking water for 331 people in Chitwan

In the village of Naibendi Gochhirang, 62 households will gain access to safe drinking water, sanitation facilities and hygiene training, benefiting a total of 331 people.

This is the project we are currently initiating and supporting. It focuses on communities largely consisting of ethnic minorities who face structural socio-economic disadvantages. Access to clean water directly leads to reduced illness, improved school attendance and more time for work and development.

This is what we will deliver:

- Installation of a sustainable water system
- Construction of sanitation facilities
- Hygiene training and awareness
- Local project coordination and implementation

Local implementation and governance

The project is implemented by the local community itself. In collaboration with partners such as the Nepal Red Cross, Shanti Griha and the Unica Foundation, the project is implemented and safeguarded. Local project managers play a key role and act as the link between the team in the Netherlands and the local community.



Join us in Nepal

We will visit several communities where projects have been realised and engage directly with local communities and partners. This makes the impact of our joint investment visible and tangible.

We will also visit the current project in Chitwan, allowing participants to see on site how their contribution is being used and what impact it has on the community.

The journey is planned for October / November 2026. Participation in the journey is linked to a contribution to the project in Chitwan. We offer different forms of participation, depending on the desired level of involvement. More information can be found on the next page.

- Planned travel period: October / November 2026
- Total travel duration: approximately 10 days

- Prices are based on estimated flight costs of €1,300 (return Netherlands – Nepal)
- A final decision on whether the trip will proceed will be made in August
- Travel is subject to external circumstances
