General Information

Galapagos Islands

Located 600 miles (965 km) off of mainland Ecuador, the Galapagos Islands lay in the Pacific Ocean, consisting of 13 main islands, of which 4 are inhabited while there are hundreds of islets and smaller islands of various rock formations. The islands have approximately 25,000 inhabitants together. In the Galapagos and the surrounding marine reserve, you can find endemic animal species. Species like the Giant tortoise, Flightless Cormorant, Fur seals, and Galapagos penguins are not found anywhere else in the world, just one of the many reasons that make the Galapagos Islands so special. Due to the unique natural processes, such as the ongoing seismic and volcanic activity and the extremely isolated location of the islands, these species have learned to survive via evolution. This has resulted in the development of extraordinary animal life in the Galapagos. For this same reason, the marine reserve has been called a "living museum and a showcase of evolution". In 1835, Charles Darwin first visited the Galapagos, which contributed to the development of his theory of evolution which has immortalized his name and connection to the Galapagos for the rest of all time.

Weather in Galapagos

The climate of the Galápagos Islands is not tropical, even though it is positioned on the equator. There is no best or worst time to go. It is important to mention the differences in seasons, which is a warm season from December through June and a cool season from July through November. The warm season is characterized by a mixture of warmth, rain, and sun. The cooler season is a mixture of cloudy, cool, and dry weather. This variation is caused by ocean currents. The temperatures vary from 70°F (21°C) to 85°F (30°C).

Flying to the Galapagos

If you plan to book a flight to the Galapagos Islands, please note the different rates for international visitors and residents. If you purchased a resident flight, you may be subject to paying an additional cost upon check-in.

When flying to the Galapagos Islands, keep in mind the following procedures.

- 1. Check your bags through SICGAL before checking in to your flight.
- 2. After checking your bags with SICGAL, purchase the Transit Control Card TCT or "Ingala" Card. \$20 USD per person and can only be paid in cash.
- 3. Upon arriving in Galapagos, pay the \$100 USD per person and \$50 per child under 12 years of age. This can only be paid in cash

Connectivity in the Galapagos Islands

Connectivity to WiFi and cell phone use in the Galapagos Islands is limited due to the remote location and conservation efforts. While some places provide WiFi (sometimes at an additional cost such as on cruises), it is often slow and unreliable, and cell phone signal coverage can be patchy in secluded areas. Visitors are encouraged to disconnect from their devices









and fully experience the natural wonders of the archipelago, respecting its delicate balance as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Local Inter-Island Galapagos Flights

If you are easily seasick and or you are not fond of speedboats for an extended period of time, it is recommended to take a local inter-island flight. The Galapagos planes have the capacity for up to 12 passengers. The experience of inter-island flights is also a unique way to experience the Galapagos Islands with an aerial view from above.

Day by Day Travel Plan

Day 1 10-02-2024

Transfer in San Cristobal airport - hotel

At the arrivals area of San Cristobal Airport, your driver will be waiting to pick you up and will bring you to your selected hotel in the village of Puerto Baquerizo Moreno. The drive takes about 5 minutes.

Interpretation Center + Tijeretas + Punta Carola

You will be picked up at your hotel and brought to the Interpretation Center, the facilities that offer the IC take us through the history of the islands, the natural and human context of the island, and the conservation.

The Natural History Room explains the natural circumstances of the volcanic origination of the islands, the distance from the continent, the sea currents, the unique weather, the arrival of different species, their establishment, and others.

The Natural Human History Room shows the chronological and most significant events related to the discovery and colonization of the Galápagos.

The second stage exposes today s reality of Galápagos: the problem and the battle that matter to some institutions and people to conserve Galápagos.

Once the Interpretation Center visit has come to an end, the trail continues to Tijeretas. The name Tijeretas is how the frigates are commonly known. Is located near Puerto Baquerizo Moreno. Close to this place used to work La Predial, it was a fishing society that existed on the island between 1952 and 1960.

There are some nooks where you can appreciate beautiful landscapes, there is also a creek where you can do snorkeling and observe sea lions, sea turtles, rays, and a great variety of fish. Is one of the unique places where you can observe the frigates nesting.

After a relaxing snorkeling, you will visit Punta Carola whose main attraction is its wildlife. Sea lions can be observed lounging on the beaches and swimming in the surrounding waters. Visitors can often spot these playful creatures up close and even snorkel alongside them. The area is also home to various marine birds, including blue-footed boobies and frigatebirds, which can be seen nesting and fishing in the vicinity.







Apart from its wildlife, Punta Carola offers breathtaking views of the ocean and the neighboring islands. The jagged cliffs and rocky outcrops create a picturesque backdrop against the deep blue sea. Many visitors enjoy taking leisurely walks along the shoreline, exploring tide pools, and enjoying the peaceful atmosphere.

The beach is relatively secluded, providing a tranquil escape for those seeking relaxation and natural beauty.

Casa Opuntia or similar

Day 2 11-02-2024 San Cristobal Highlands Half Day (El Junco, La Galapaquera & Puerto Chino)

Today you will visit the highlands of San Cristobal island. After about 30 minutes driving you arrive to the El Junco, a big sweet water lagoon of 270 m diameter. This is the only sweet water lagoon of the Galapagos Islands. After a little walk at the lagoon you continue for about 20 minutes by car and you get to La Galapaguera. Here you find different native Galapagos plants and tortoises. You finish the highlands tour at the beach of Puerto Chino where you can snorkel.



La Loberia Self-quide Visit

La Loberia is about a 2 km hike from town. The beach itself is very beautiful but it is recommended to wear water shoes or sandals for in and out of the water as it is a rocky entrance with a white sandy beach. There are many sea lions, hence the name "La Loberia". There is great snorkeling and it is a perfect swimming area and there is a shady spot on the beach as well to relax in. Sunsets are also gorgeous at this location. Beyond the beach, there is another trail across lava rocks that lead to Las Negritas. It is a moderate hike and there is known to be blue- footed boobies and frigatebirds in the area.

Day 3 12-02-2024

San Cristobal Airport Transfer Out

You will be picked up at your hotel and brought to San Cristobal Airport for your departing flight. The drive will take about 5 minutes.

Flight San Cristobal - Isabela

This short flight of about 45 minutes gives you the chance to experience Galapagos Islands from the air. These planes are small and hold up to 9 passengers.

Transfer Isabela airport - hotel

You will be picked up at Isabela airport and brought to your hotel in Puerto Villamil. This drive takes about 7 minutes.

Tintoreras Islet

Today you will visit Tintoreras Islet. White-tipped sharks known as Tintoreras come daily to rest at the bottom of the ocean floor in the warm water.

To arrive, you will go to the pier of Puerto Villamil and board a speedboat to cross over to the islet which is located across the bay. It will be necessary to use walking shoes or sneakers (or closed-toed sandals) to cross the volcanic rocks for a short walk. You also have the opportunity to do some snorkeling with sea lions and with some fortune, there may be some penguins.











Day 4 13-02-2024

Los Tuneles Snorkeling Tour

You will be brought to the passenger pier to be taken to what is known as one of the best snorkeling locations in the world, Los Tuneles or "The Tunnels". It will be about 45 minutes to arrive via speedboat. The water is shallow, calm, and very clear, allowing you to view the sea sanctuary below you. There is a series of lava flows that have produced unique geological formations like arcs and tunnels underneath and above the water. This has created a habitat for many local Galapagos species.



The entrance to the site is shallow and the waves can be strong, enter with care and follow the instructions of the guide. You will have a snack during the tour. After the tour, you will return to Puerto Villamil and be dropped off at your hotel.





Isabela Wetlands Self Guided Biking

You can pick up your rented bikes in the village of Isabela and from there you can bike to the Giant Tortoise Breeding Center. You will be able to spot young and old Giant tortoises in their natural habitat. From here you can continue biking to the Wall of Tears. Along the way, you even have a great chance to see the Giant tortoises near the road and you can enjoy incredible views across the island.



Kayaking at Puerto Villamil

After breakfast, your guide will meet you at your hotel and accompany you for a kayak excursion in the bay of Puerto Villamil, Isabela.

This activity is a great way to explore the shores of Isabela Island and see a wide array of tropical fish, a variety of sharks, sea turtles, Galapagos penguins, blue-footed boobies, and many other Galapagos shore birds.

Day 6 15-02-2024

Sierra Negra Volcano hike

Today you will be picked up at approximately 7:30 a.m. for an excursion to the Sierra Negra Volcano a shared excursion to the top of the volcano. The Sierra Negra Volcano is located 13 miles from Puerto Villamil and has the second largest volcanic crater in the world, 6 miles wide and 300 feet deep. You will travel in a shared bus for 45 minutes until you reach the starting point to begin the hike to the rim of the Sierra Negra Volcano. This hike takes approximately 4 hours. It can be very hot and dry, so it is very important to bring water, wear a hat, and lightweight clothing. The hike begins at 870 meters asl and at the top of the crater, you will have reached 1040 meters. You will be given boxed lunch options at the beginning of the tour so that you can enjoy it whenever you would like during the tour.





Day 7 16-02-2024

Transfer out Isabela Hotel - Airport

You will be picked up at your hotel in Puerto Villamil and dropped off at Isabela airport. This drive takes about 10 minutes.

Flight Isabela - Baltra

This short flight of about 40 minutes gives you the chance to experience Galapagos Islands from the air. These planes are small and hold up to 9 passengers.

Transfer in Baltra to Puerto Ayora

Upon arrival at Baltra Airport (GPS), you will take a bus to the Itabaca channel. This bus takes about 10 minutes.







Once you arrive at the Itabaca channel you will take a ferry to cross the channel to Santa Cruz Island. The ferry ride costs \$1 USD per person.

Upon arrival to Santa Cruz, you will be provided private transportation to the small town of Puerto Ayora, this ride takes about 45 minutes passing through the highlands.

Tortuga Bay Self Guided

If you have time you can do this self guided activity while in Puerto Ayora. You can visit one of the most beautiful beaches of the Galapagos Islands. The walk from Puerto Ayora village to takes about 25 minutes. This white sand and turquoise water pristine beach is ideal to have a quiet beach day, rent some kayaks and see groups of marine iguanas that are regulating their temperature on the rocks and sand. Take enough water and some snacks with you, since there is no place to buy food or water.



Usually the National Park only let you start the walk to Tortuga Bay untill 3PM.

Day 8 17-02-2024

North Seymour

After breakfast, you go by car to the Itabaca channel (about 40 minutes). From there you go by boat to North Seymour (about 30 minutes). You will do a short hike and you can go snorkeling. You will have a box lunch on board. On your return, you will drop off at Pto. Ayora public dock, you can walk to your hotel and enjoy the town lifestyle.





Day 9 18-02-2024

Biking Santa Cruz Highlands - Playa Garrapatero

Today you will have a mountain biking expedition with an English-speaking guide. You will start in Puerto Ayora and you will go to the highlands of Santa Cruz to see the giant tortoises in their natural habitat.



You will also have the opportunity to explore the Santa Cruz lava tunnels!

After a short visit to one of the ranches where you can come very close to the Giant tortoises, you will bike to Garrapatero Beach. Here you can enjoy a refreshing dive into the sea. From here you will bike back to Puerto Ayora.



Day 10 19-02-2024

Transfer out Puerto Ayora to Baltra

You will have a transfer from Puerto Ayora to the Baltra Airport about 3 hours before the departure of your flight. This time will be coordinated before you travel.

The transfer will take about 45 minutes until you reach the Itabacca Channel. The ferry will then take you to the other side of the channel, about ten minutes. Once you arrive, you will continue by bus to the airport.
