

Processing and maintenance of natural stone products

Follow the steps below to get a good result:

- It is a natural product, so there will be colour differences between the different sheets. Search for the best colour match before you proceed.
- Provide a smooth surface and use the natural stone mosaic preferably with paste glue. Check the glue manufacturer's website to know exactly how to apply the glue.
- The sheets come together thanks to the "inter-lock" system. Keep an eye on the joint width for the best result.
- If necessary, use an angle grinder with diamond blade to cut the stones.
- After the glue has hardened, you can start with adding the grout. Look for the instructions on the website of the chosen brand.
- Finally, the mosaic and grout should be given a transparent coating (impregnation) to prevent dirt from easily getting into the porous material. Depending on the application, a new coating must be applied every 4 to 5 years.



Maintenance:

- Natural stone is not resistant to acids! Do not use cleaning material containing acids.
- Also a coating / impregnation, does not protect against acids. Keep in mind that acids (from fruit juice, wine, cola, etc.) leave a stain unless it is treated immediately with plenty of water.
- Stains caused by, among other things, acids can only be removed by a specialist by grinding the top layer of the floor.
